The diver can freely choose the dives from the dive table given in the FINA Handbook. The only requirement is that in age groups 16 – 69 years, each dive performed has different dive number (as to FINA Handbook).

In age groups 70+ dives with the same dive number can be repeated, if performed in a different position (straight, pike, tuck or free position).

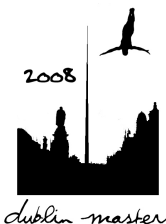

In this competition we will be using an electronic system of scoring called **DiveRecorder** (www.diverecorder.co.uk). If you are using DiveRecorder to enter your dives, please enter them **no later than Sunday September 21st**.

To submit your dive sheets:

Go to [http://www.diverecorder.co.uk/](http://www.diverecorder.co.uk) and select the "Online Sheets" tab.

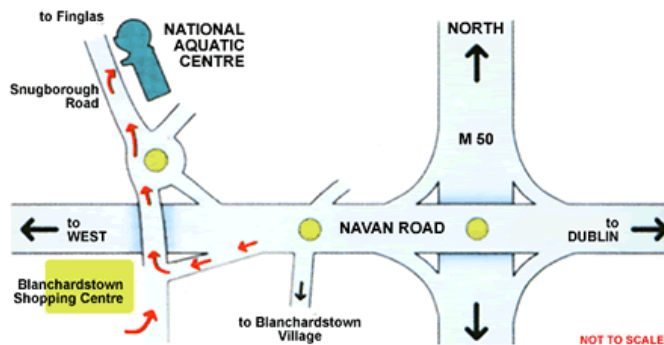
1. Choose a forthcoming Meet (Dublin Masters Open Diving Championships 2008)
2. Enter your details: name, club, year of birth, gender. "Club Code" is an arbitrary code, use any 3 letters that are recognisable as your club.
3. Choose an Event
4. Fill in your dive sheet
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 for each event you have entered
6. Check and make any necessary corrections
7. Finally, Submit your sheets .. or Abort. Note that you can Abort at any time before actually 'submitting' your sheets.

Directions To The National Aquatic Centre

By Bus from the City Centre.

Please take the 38A from the Hawkins Street in the City Centre to Snugborough Road in Blanchardstown

By Car from the City Centre.

Take the Navan Road (N3) to the Blanchardstown M50 Roundabout. Continue straight through the roundabout and also through the Blanchardstown village roundabout. 500 metres after the village roundabout, take the slip road to the left and stay in the right hand lane. Take a right at the top of the slip road and cross over the bridge. Take the first exit off the small roundabout at the other side of the bridge. Continue up Snugborough Road and take a right at the second set of traffic lights into the National Aquatic Centre.

By car from the M50.

Take the exit at junction 6 on the M50 for Blanchardstown. Continue straight through the Blanchardstown Village roundabout. 500 metres after the village roundabout, take the slip road to the left and stay in the right hand lane. Take a right at the top of the slip road and cross over the bridge. Take the first exit off the small roundabout at the other side of the bridge. Continue up Snugborough Road and take a right at the second set of traffic lights into the National Aquatic Centre.

By Car from the Blanchardstown Centre.

Exit the Blanchardstown Centre complex via the Westpoint Health Club exit. Continue to the set of traffic lights and take a left over the bridge. Take the first exit off the small roundabout at the other side of the bridge. Continue up Snugborough Road and take a right at the second set of traffic lights into the National Aquatic Centre
